**Chapter 7A of the California Building Code—Materials and Construction Methods for Exterior Wildfire Exposure** was approved by the Building Standards Commission and became effective January 2008. This new chapter of the code applies to new construction in Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) areas. It establishes minimum standards for the protection of life and property by increasing the ability of a building to resist intrusion of flame and burning embers.

Sessions will provide working knowledge of this new chapter in the California Building Code with:

3. Information on the State Fire Marshal Building Materials Listing (BML) program that provides a procedure for testing, labeling, and listing products that comply for use.

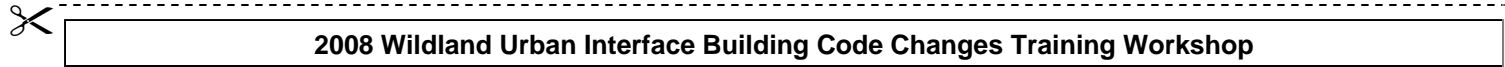
